MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm there are now 433 ACTIVE cases of COVID-19. That number includes 55 hospitalizations. 224 people have fully recovered! The number of total positive cases has increased 10 since yesterday to 672.

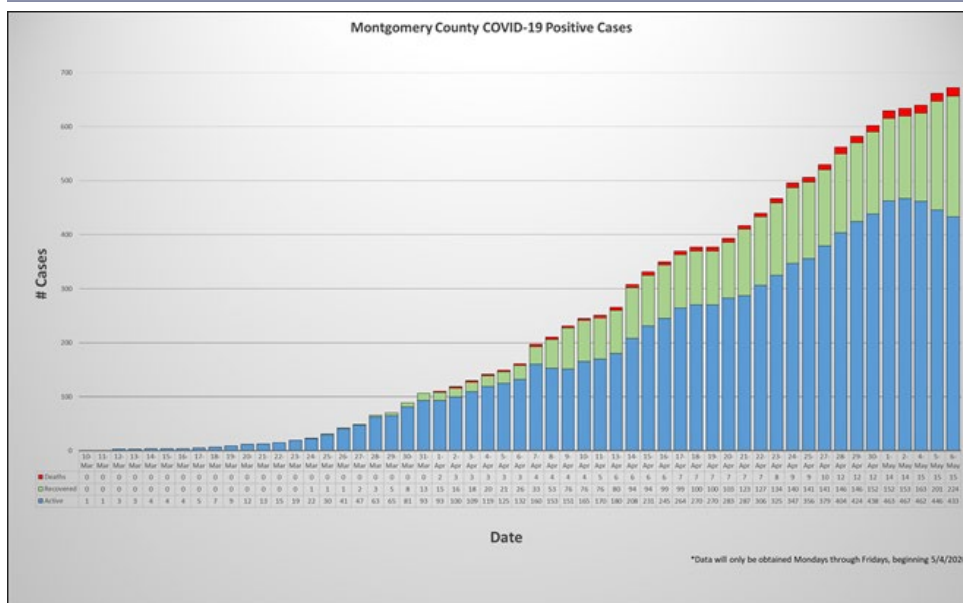
