## **MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE**

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm the number of ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 has decreased to 425 today. That number includes 52 hospitalizations. 249 people have fully recovered! The number of total positive cases has increased 17 since yesterday to 689.

A mobile testing clinic will be in our area this Sunday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. The tests are by appointment only. See the attached flyer for more details.

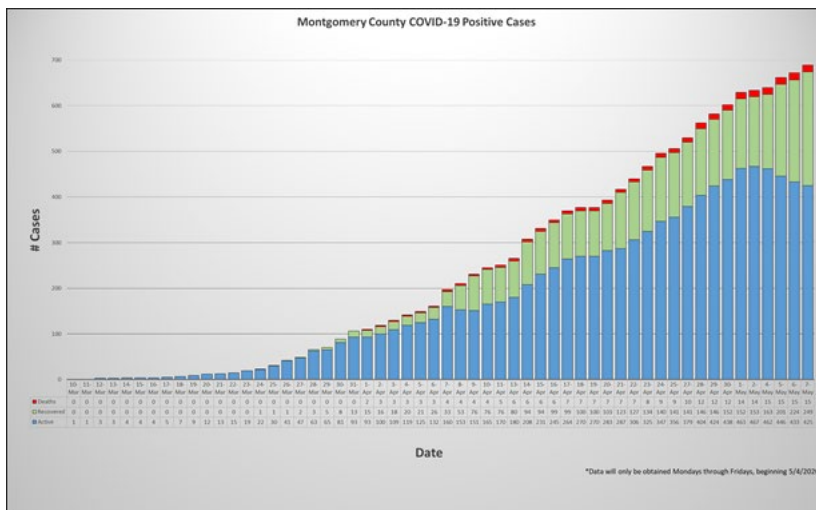
