MONTGOMERY COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm the number of ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 has increased to 470 today. That number includes 27 hospitalizations. 444 people have fully recovered. The number of total positive cases has increased 14 since yesterday to 940.

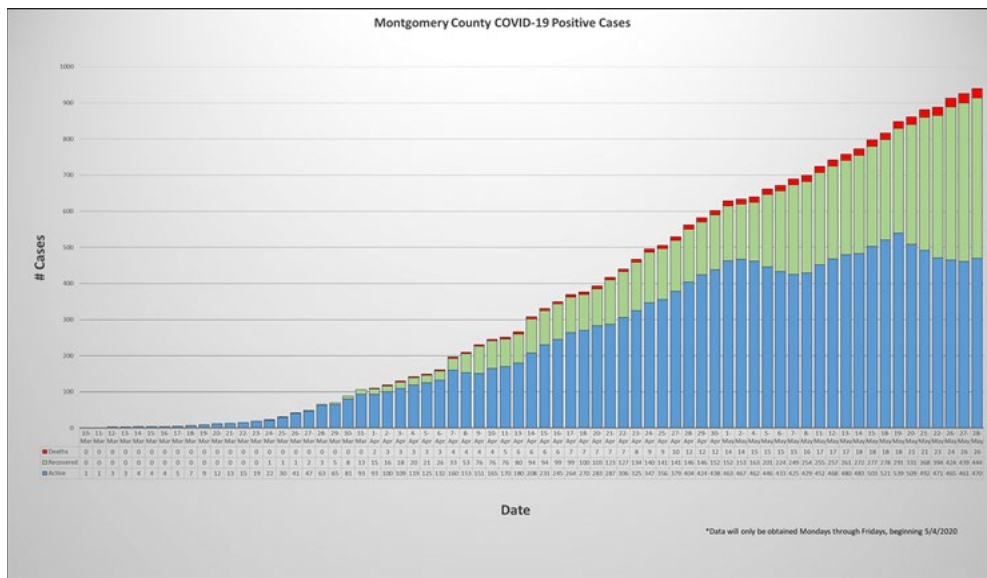
