## CIVILIAN RESPONSE & CASUALTY CARE COURSE

Montgomery County Public Health District will be having a **Civilian Response and Casualty Care (CRCC) Course** on November 23<sup>rd</sup> from 8:30am to 12:30pm. It will be held in the Boardroom (Room 180) of MCHD's Administration Building. The course is designed and built on the Avoid, Deny, Defend (ADD) strategy developed by ALERRT in 2004. It provides strategies, guidance and a proven plan for surviving

an active shooter event. This course combines the civilian response with the Stop the Bleed Campaign, which empowers civilians to provide life-saving medical aid before first responders ever arrive.
